

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This MoU is made between

Hindustan College of Science & Technology (HCST), Mathura, U.P., India, 281122

AND


Eshan College of Engineering (ECE), Farah, Mathura, U.P., India, 281122

It is hereby agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) Both parties are agreed to submit collaborative research project for funding.
- 2) Both parties are agreed to mutual academic audit for quality improvement in outcome-based education
- 3) Both parties are agreed to exchange their quality assurance processes, review mechanisms, and assessment tools. This can help identify gaps and areas for improvement in both institutions.
- 4) PhD students can be supervised on shared basis and that other party is added as an additional supervisor.
- 5) Under this understanding between IQAC, HCST and IQAC, ECE hereby a formal understanding of cooperation which is intended to further the academic and research objectives and to promote better understanding between their students. Under this Memorandum of Understanding, Joint research activities will proceed.
- 6) That, the purpose of this MOU is to define the areas for fundamental academic research in which the parties desire to work together for the benefit of student and foster a collaborative framework.
- 7) The MoU shall have initial duration of five years from the date of signature unless either party gives the six months' notice for termination.
- 8) Ultimate responsibility of this MoU lies with both parties.
- 9) The parties agree that this MoU is not a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship right duties or consequences, but it is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the parties to which the parties are bound in honour only.
- 10) The implementation of this MoU shall be constructed and governed accordance with Laws of India.



### AND

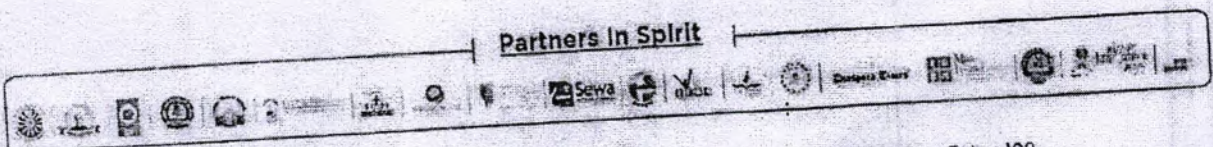

### WHERE AS:

A.) D. Both Parties, desire to sign an MOU for advancing their mutual interests with Higher Education Students wherein the First Party shall be designing and developing a specific module on Value Education based on the purpose of "Global Competencies through Global citizenry"

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Parties agree as follows:

#### CLAUSE 1 CO OPERATION

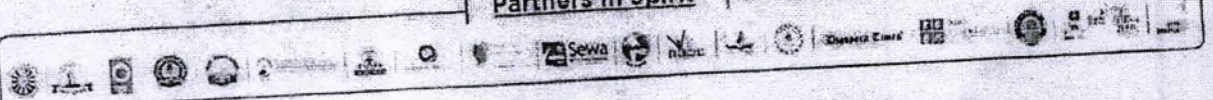
- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interest and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

#### CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU




2.1 Creating NEP based Structured Moral Values Courses for Higher Education Student – The second party shall create a structured course for delivering Moral Value Programs for Higher Education Students.

2.2. **Process:** The second party shall create the process of delivering this module which will be a Hybrid Module covering both Online and Offline sessions. Would also make the Concept clarification, help the Institute faculties for the Concept Mapping and the last stage of Concept realization. Research to be done as the last leg to know the efficacy of the program so that future improvements are possible

2.3 **Levels of the Program with Credits** - There are three levels for the Program. Any student can take the program, at any level. Continue to complete all the three levels/or each level and drop when completed. He/she will be credited proportionate to the number of hours attended by the student.

**Level-I:** 30 hr Certificate Program - jointly signed by the Hindustan College of Science and Technology, Mathura and HEMA Foundation

**Level-II**-60 hr – Diploma Program- jointly signed by the Hindustan College of Science and Technology, Mathura and HEMA Foundation

**Level III-** 120 hrs – Advanced Diploma Program - jointly signed by the Hindustan College of Science and Technology, Mathura and HEMA Foundation

2.4. **Methods for training adopted:** The Second Party will conduct workshops and training sessions for students through some of these forms - Story telling, Case study, Debate, Discussion, Street plays, Social outreach program, Engaging the social media, Film making, Making use of the art forms, Guest Lectures etc.

2.5. **No costs involved:** The second party will be providing its entire content - without any charge to the First Party however, HEMA Foundation shall retain the intellectual Property rights of the content and modules.

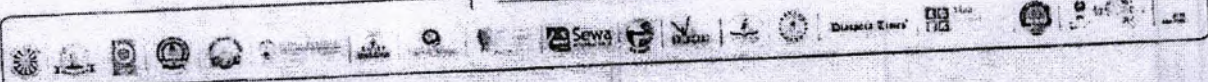
2.6 **Faculty Development Programmes:** Second Party may train the Faculty of First Party for imparting moral value education and in this case the First party can be the Nodal Institution for implementation of Value Education Programs by engaging schools in and around the region of location.

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party. Both parties may, in their brochures or website or other documents use the name and logo of the other party for the purpose of mentioning the existence of their contractual relationship.

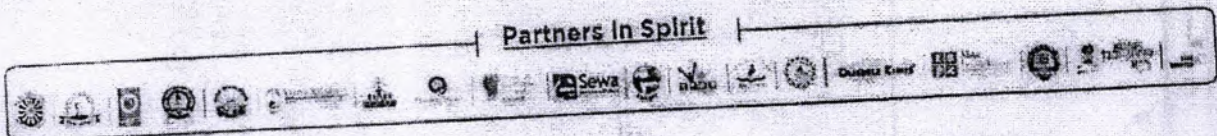
### CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

### CLAUSE 6 DISPUTE SETTLEMENT

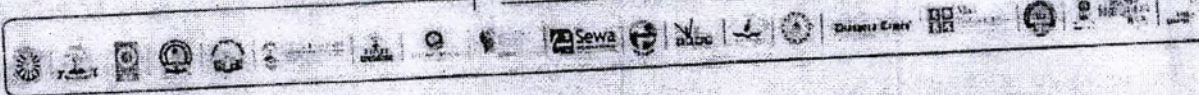


